# OLC's Youth Sailing Programs

## **OUR PROGRAM**

OLC's sailing school is thoughtfully designed to introduce new skills while continually building upon foundational ones. We are committed to teaching children the art of sailing, along with the values of sportsmanship, teamwork, and camaraderie. Above all, we strive to create an environment where young sailors have fun, gain confidence, and develop a lifelong love of being on the water.

## **GEAR**

Sailors should bring the following items to class each day:

- Life Jacket (to be worn and zipped shore to shore).
- Whistle (attached to lifejacket and only to be used for distress calls).
- Swimwear/Lake Clothes
- Shoes (old tennis shoes and Chaco's tend to work well, crocs and flip flops are NOT recommended as they are harder to keep on while swimming).
- Water Bottle – there will be an area to refill once they are here.
- Snack – Sailing is in the afternoon after the lunch hour. Please make sure that your sailor(s) are fed prior to dropping them off.
- Optional Gear
  - Sailing Watch (no other jewelry can be worn).
  - Clothes that are easy to move in.
  - Sunscreen, Sunglasses, hats, visors.
  - Towel and a change of clothing (in case your sailor takes a dip in the lake).

## **ATTENDANCE**

Please let us know in advance if your sailor will be missing a class so that our instructors don't waste time waiting for them on shore. Please email planned absences to [bergen0504@gmail.com](mailto:bergen0504@gmail.com). If it is a last-minute absence, please text Bergen Fischer (phone number will be provided to all enrolled students). You as parents are responsible for getting your sailors to class as well as picking them up afterwards on time. A \$10 fee will be charged for pickups that occur later than 15 minutes after the completion of class.

## **EXPECTATIONS**

Please review the contents of this document with your sailor(s). Parents should encourage sportsmanlike behavior including adherence to class rules, respect for equipment, observance of proper sailing etiquette, and being a gracious winner or loser and being respectful of fellow sailors. Only registered OLC sailors will be able to participate in class. This is for insurance purposes. Please do not bring friends to class.

Only registered OLC Sailing School coach boats are allowed to tie up to the east pier during class, so families, please do not bring your boats and leave them tied up to the east pier for an extended period of time on class days. It is OLC policy that no dogs are allowed on or around the pier area of the club.

## **PARENT PARTICIPATION**

All students participating in a regatta must have a parent/guardian accompanying them for the full day.

## **PRIVATE LESSONS**

If your sailor, or you as a parent are interested in time on the water in addition to your scheduled class time, please arrange a day with one of the instructors. The cost is based on an hourly rate. Please reach out to Bergen Fischer for additional information.

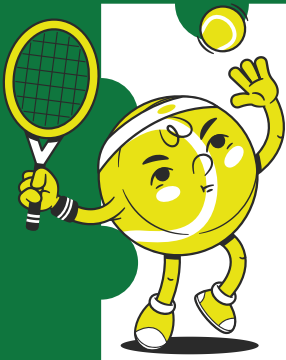

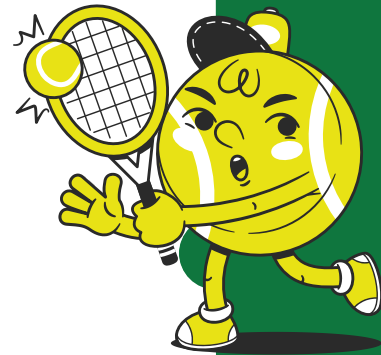
# YOUTH TENNIS PROGRAM

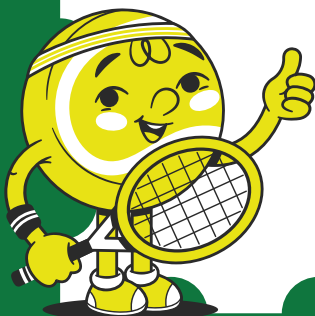

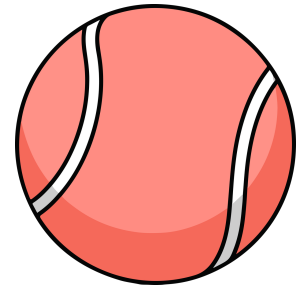

## Wednesdays & Fridays Classes

### Red Ball

Ages 4-6 | 10:00am - 10:45am



A fun introductory class for kids to get exposed to the game of tennis. The focus will be on developing motor skills and coordination while learning the basic strokes of tennis. The emphasis will be on having FUN.

### Orange Ball

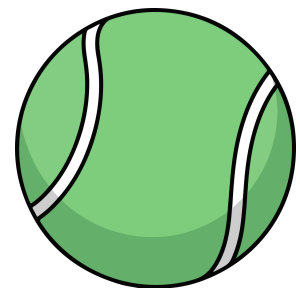
Ages 7-9 | 10:45am - 11:45am

# RACQUET DRILLS



## LADIES' MIXED DRILL & PLAY

## CARDIO TENNIS

This is a great substitute for a cardio workout while hitting tennis balls! The class concentrates on high-speed cardio tennis drills designed to maintain an elevated heart rate. The focus is on Cardio!

## JUNIOR & HIGH SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT

These players are comfortable on a full-sized court using regular balls. This class will focus on live ball rallying, point play, court awareness, while maintaining proper stroke technique.

## MEN'S INTERMEDIATE DRILL & PLAY

This drill is for players who are looking to build on court positioning, practicing different match situation scenarios, and continue to develop court awareness skills. Live ball play will be saved for the end.

## MEN'S ADVANCED DRILL & PLAY

Players with competitive singles and doubles background are welcome to come out and participate in drills that cover different doubles strategies, shot selection, competitive point play, and various match play scenarios. Live ball play will be saved for the end.

## PICKLEBALL DRILL & PLAY

All levels are welcome to come out and practice different types of live match scenarios. The focus of the drill will be practicing executing different shots and covering basic strategy. Live ball play will be saved for the end.

## OLC ACADEMY

The highest level of the Junior Program. This is for High School & USTA players with the focus being on advanced tactics, positioning, and footwork. *\*Tournament or High School tennis experience is required*

# Using the OLC App

## DOWNLOADING THE APP

- Download the mobile App from the Google Play or Apple Store.
- In the search bar of the appropriate store, type in “Oconomowoc Lake Club”. Our App will have a white square with our logo in it. Click install.
- After you have installed and opened the App on your mobile phone, enter your member number & password. This will be the same log-in for the online portal on our website. When complete, select the green button.
- You can now log in to our mobile App to place reservations for dining, tennis drills & courts or pontoon rentals.

## SIGNING UP FOR A DRILL/TOURNAMENT

- In the OLC App, Locate the “Menu” tab on the bottom of the screen.
- Select “Upcoming Events.”
- Locate the event you are registering for. (Please note reservations for drills open one week in advance, and close 12 hours before the drill.)
- Click the event & locate the “Reserve” button at the bottom of the page.
- Using quick select at the top of the screen, select the member you would like to sign up.
- Once finished, please select “Create Reservation” at the bottom of the screen.

## RESERVING A COURT

- In the OLC App, Locate the “Menu” tab on the bottom of the screen.
- Under “Reservations”, click “Tennis”.
- Using the Calendar at the top of the screen, locate the date you are looking to reserve a court.
- Using the drop-down arrow located under the calendar, next to the court, select the court number you would like to reserve. (Clay Court - Court 3 | Pickleball Courts - Courts 4 & 5)
- Select the time slot you would like to reserve a court for.
- Duration: Select the amount of time you would like to reserve the court for. There is a 90 min max. If you need a court for a longer amount of time, please contact the office.
- Res. Type: Please leave at “Open Reservation”.
- If you are looking for a partner, press the toggle next to this line so it turns green.
- Add other members if necessary.
- Once complete, please click “Reserve”.
